Tuckahoe-Eastchester Lions Club Scholarship Policy & Procedure 2010

Overview

The Tuckahoe-Eastchester Lions Club annually grants \$500.00 Scholarships to graduating high school seniors residing in the Town of Eastchester. The award is given directly to the student and can be used for any expenses connected with attending college.

Submission Criteria

- Applicants must submit a detailed description of their service activities that describes the organizations that they worked with and what was achieved.
- Applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation on school letterhead from the student's principal, assistant principal or guidance counselor.
- Deadline for applications is May 15, 2010.

Selection Criteria

- Student must demonstrate that he/she has been actively involved in service activities for the betterment of the community during his/her high school years. Examples of activities include membership in organizations such as auxiliary police, volunteer at local hospital or senior citizen home; working with a youth organization; an active Leo Club member; working with groups that aid the poor, homeless, etc.
- Character: Demonstrates an overall sense of good moral character and citizenship.
- Scholarship: Student must have maintained a grade point average of 80% or better for his/her high school years.
